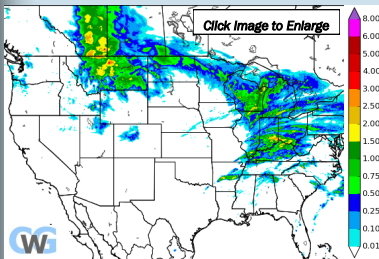

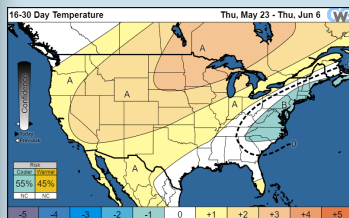
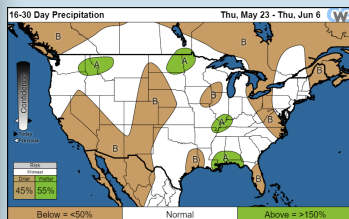
Break After Tomorrow Aids Midwest Seeding Until Mid Next Week

1/2 Russia Winter Wheat Remains Too Dry Next 2 Weeks

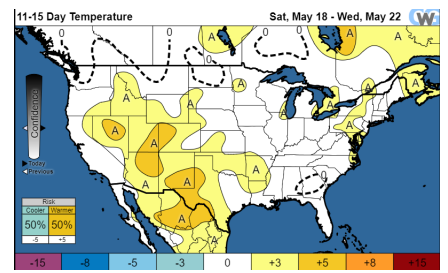
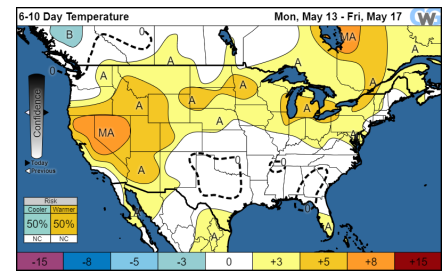
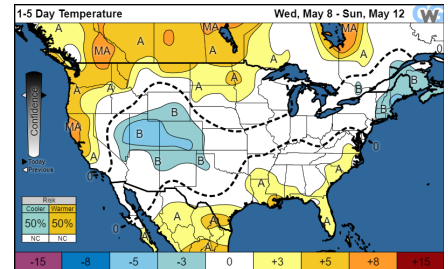
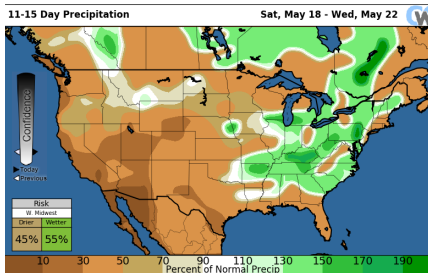
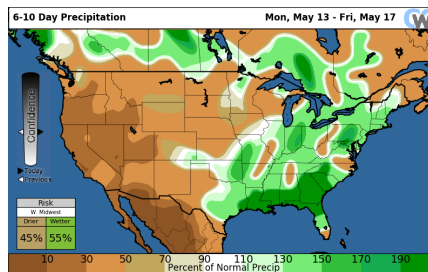
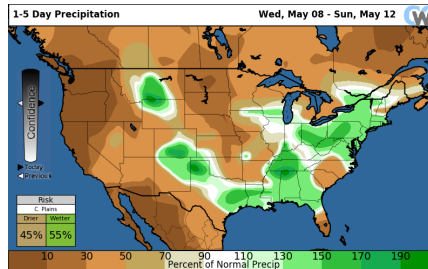
Past 24-Hour Totals



16-30 Day Summary



- Favor **Midwest** pattern to remain active but not enough showers for additional major slowdowns; -PNA still poses wetter risks
- Wetter **Can. Prairies** aids moisture; wheat/canola seeding interruptions minimal



North American Highlights

- Thundershowers focus **N. IA to E. Midwest/Delta** today into tomorrow morning
- 5-6 day drier break aids **Midwest** seeding recovery, especially in **NE/IA**
- Stress in **20% S. Plains** wheat may narrow further late weekend/next week
- **NW Plains/W. Prairies** showers linger today; seeding pace then improves

International Highlights

- 1/2 **Russia** winter wheat remains moisture stressed next two weeks
- **Argentina** corn/soy harvest pace improves under drier pattern after today
- Wetter **SE Australia** wheat/canola this week; early stress persists in **40%**
