**6-10 Day Drier C. & SW Midwest/Pacific NW; Wetter N. Delta**  
**11-15 Day Wetter Delta/C. Plains/Pacific NW; Drier Far S. Plains**

**Today's Model Rating:** Locally 5 to nearly 10" next week in N. Delta probably overstated but will need to monitor

- 1-5 Day:** - Wetter SW & far E. IA, S. WI, SW MI, N. AL, E. AR, SE NE - Drier NE OK, IL  
 - Drier risks C. Midwest/E. Plains/S. Delta but no forecast changes
- 6-10 Day:** - Wetter (locally 3 to 6") in AR, N. MS, TN, SE MO, E. OK - Drier OR, WA, C. MN, SW MI, C. IN, C. IL, C. MO  
 - Drier risk in Pacific NW, and threat for heavier totals in N. Delta
- 11-15 Day:** - Wetter S. & E. KS, W. MO, E. OK, Delta/Southeast, OR - Drier TX  
 - Wetter risk C. Plains and drier risks S. Midwest/SE Plains, but overall a closer fit to our outlook than earlier solution
